<p><b>Policy</b></p>	<p><b><u>Aggressive Behavior Policy:</u></b></p> <p>CBRRR does not accept dogs with histories of aggression towards humans, property, and animals. Aggression, in this matter, is any history of behavior that has led to injury. Specifically, a dog with a bite incident that would rate higher than three (3) on the Dunbar Scale may not, under any circumstances, be accepted into CBRR&amp;R.</p>

<p><b>Procedures</b></p>	<p><b><u>Acceptance of a surrendered dogs:</u></b></p> <p>A dog with a history of aggression that ranks one (1) or two (2) on the Dunbar Scale must be further evaluated. A level 3 dog may only enter CBRR&amp;R Foster Program with consideration and approval of the Board. Under certain circumstances and only with Board approval, CBRR&amp;R may accept a dog with a report of aggression if the behavior did not result in broken skin and is <b>not dangerous</b>. Additionally, the dog’s prognosis for remediation of the behavioral issues is determined to be good with proper treatment.</p>
